MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is being executed this ______ day of ______ day of ______ 2020 between the UT Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu and the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Vadodara hereinafter "IIITV".

WHEREAS Indian Institute of Information Technology Vadodara (IIITV) is established by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India under Public Private Partnership (PPP) as an Institute of National Importance enacted by Act of Parliament IIIT PPP Act 2017 with a view to develop knowledge base in information technology and to provide manpower of global standards for the information technology industry and to provide for certain other matters connected with such institutions or incidental thereto.

Whereas, The partners in IIITV are Government of India (50%), Government of Gujarat (35%), Gujarat Energy Research and Management Institute (5%), Gujarat State Fertilizers (5%) and Chemicals and Tata Consultancy Services (5%).

- b) Achieve international standards in student faculty ratio, doctoral students to Post graduate students ratio, research output, publications in quality journals and placement of students.
- c) Improve the quality of life of people in General and socio-economic environment in and around the institute in particular through outreach and social responsibility activities.
- d) Develop State of the Art infrastructure and a suitable environment to achieve the vision and mission of the institute.
- e) Attract talented human resources to join in Masters and PhD programmes and recruit top quality faculty members.

f) Hire highly qualified, faculties and staff to provide quality education and promote cutting edge research.

g) Make significant contribution to technology development and transfer the same towards nation development.

Whereas, The Union Territory Administration of Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman and Diu is looking for setting up of an Institute of excellence that would provide world class opportunities to the students at the Education Hub, Diu, UT of DNH and DD and create an atmosphere of intense academic pursuits along with development of skilled IT related manpower.

NOW Therefore the two parties have agreed to facilitate establishment of an International Campus of IIIT Vadodara at Education Hub, Diu as follows:-

Obligation of IIIT Vadodara

- IIIT Vadodara will play a key role in establishing IIITV International
 Campus at Education Hub, Diu to be named as Indian Institute of
 Information Technology Vadodara International Campus Diu
 (IIITVICD), with the support of UT Administration of DNH And DD and
 achieve its objectives through
 - a. Academic programmes at Undergraduate, Postgraduate and doctoral studies
 - Building a strong ecosystem for innovation and research in form of an innovation/incubation cell
 - c. Developing an advanced centre for continuing education programme emphasizing on industry standards and focusing on training programmes.
- 2. Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) in Computer Science and engineering will start in the academic year 2020-21 with an intake of 120. The seats in the existing programmes will be increased as per the demand of programme or new academic programmes will be introduced after taking into consideration the infrastructure available

- and other related parameters. However, the projection of seats will be governed as per Para 20 of the Detailed Project Report. Any Deviation in this regard will require the concurrence of BoG.
- Master of Technology/Master of Science Program/ Master of 3. Information Technology and Business Administration will be started in the academic year 2021-22 and the number of seats will be decided later as per the approval of IIITV BoG and in consultation with UT Administration.
- 4. Doctoral Program in Engineering and Science will be started at the earliest.
- 5. Admission policy of Academic programmes will be as per Clause 16. 17 and 18 of the report attached with the following changes in clause 16.
 - a. 75% seats will be filled by All India Students
 - b. 25% seats will be reserved for International Students. Distribution of which will be decided by BoG IIITV in consultation with UT Administration depending upon the demand.
- 6. Reservation policy shall be governed by Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act. 2006.
- 7. Fee Structure of IIIT Vadodara will be as per clause 22 and Clause 23 of the report attached for AY 2020-21. Fee will be revised as per the decision of IIITV BoG.
- 8. IIIT Vadodara will invite Secretary (Higher and Technical Education) in all its board meetings as special invitee for the matter related to IIITVCD.
- 9. IIIT Vadodara will invite Secretary (Finance) in all meetings of its Finance committee for the matter related to IIITVCD as special invitee.
- The fund provided by the UT Administration will be used for purposes 10. other than payment of salary and No funds will be transferred from IIITV International Campus without approval of UT of DNH & DD.

- 11. The recurring fund provided by UT will not be used for paying salary except done after approval of UT of DNH and DD. The expenditure incurred for payment of salary by UT Administration shall be returned back when IIITVCD becomes self-sufficient in subsequent years.
- **12.** All decisions of MHRD would be final and binding on the Institute as it is to be governed under IIIT PPP Act 2017.
- 13. IIITVICD will have Independent Accounting system in place.
- 14. All accounts will be audited by Comptroller and Auditor General of India in line with the audit of IIITV as per IIIT PPP Act.
- No Assets of IIITVICD, as provided by UT Administration or procured out of funds of UT Administration, will be transferred to IIITV or any of its branches.
- 16. IIITV-ICD will be open for inspections and checking of Infrastructure and facilities by officials of UT administration of DNH & DD with prior permission/ intimation.

Obligation of the UT Administration of DNH and DD

- The UT Administration will provide all capital infrastructure to the institute initially according to Annexure III. The UT of DNHDD may help to provide replacements of equipment in due course once the life of such equipment expires provided IIITIVCD does not have sufficient funds. The repair and maintenance of such equipments shall be the responsibility of IIITV.
- The Permanent physical infrastructure for IIITV will be provided by UT Administration if there is a requirement of shifting the campus due to growth of the institute other due to administrative reasons.
- 3. Repair and maintenance of Permanent civil infrastructure will be the responsibility of UT of DNH and DD.
- UT Administration of DNH and DD will provide seed money of Rs. 2.00 crore per year for first five years to IIITV-ICD for meeting recurrent expenditure such as purchase of books & stationary, travel expenses,

office expenses, legal expenses, expenditure related to student welfare/ affairs, etc. A total of INR 10 crores will be paid by UT Administration of DNH and DD).

DURATION OF THE MEMORANDUM

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect from the date of execution and shall remain in force for a period of five years and thereafter it can be renewed.

TERMINATION OF MEMORANDUM

If any of the parties, at any time, decides to terminate the memorandum by closing the institute or otherwise, a notice period of at least three years will be required to be given and future course of action would be determined by both UT of DNH&DD and BoG of IIITV together. Financial Support for these closing years, absorption of the staff, takeover of assets & liabilities and Mechanism for transition on closing of the IIITVICD to be finalized together by UT Administration of DNH&DD and BoG of IIITVICD.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

The parties shall first use reasonable endeavours to amicably settle disputes arising out of or in connection with this Collaboration Agreement.

Where a dispute has not been amicably resolved the parties shall enter into structured negotiation with the assistance of a mediator acceptable to both sides.

Where mediation fails the parties shall settle the dispute through District Court, Diu, UT of DNH and DD.

The Memorandum may be amended or revised if both parties agree. Such amendments or revision shall be effective from the date of signature. Amendments may be decided at any time and shall be made in writing upon mutual consent of the parties.
